



BIG SIX

The Big Six got its name because there are six different bets a player can make. It is the easiest casino game to play and there is very little strategy involved. This is truly a game of luck.

The wheel consists of 54 equal sections, with a peg separating each one. A flapper sits on top of the wheel at the 12 o'clock position. Each section of the wheel is marked with United States currency denominations; \$1, \$2, \$5, \$10 and \$20. Two of the sections are marked by symbols, with the number 45 accompanying them.

THE PLAY OF THE GAME

All bets must be placed prior to the spinning of the wheel. Players place their bets directly on the table on top of the number or symbol that corresponds to the numbers or symbols on the wheel. Bets must be made with casino issued chips. No cash bets on the table are accepted. You can continue to make wagers until the dealer announces, "No more bets."

Winning bets are determined by whichever number or symbol section the flapper stops in. The dealer then removes all losing bets and pays all winners and the game begins anew.

The amount of the payout for this game varies depending on the currency or symbol the flapper stops at.

Players are responsible for their own bets. Flapper coming to rest on a spindle constitutes a void game. No partnership may exceed the table maximum.
